**Why you should attend**

*Unmanned Aviation Systems (UAS) are becoming pervasive. Businesses, Hobbyists, the Military, and Law Enforcement are operating UAS in Arizona skies. Although the Federal Aviation Administration has developed a comprehensive set of regulations dealing with manned aircraft, the rules governing UAS are far from settled. In this uncertainty, cities, counties, and the State have considered measures to regulate UAS. Arizona's Constitution guarantees the right to privacy, yet commercial, hobbyist, and public UAS equipped with video capabilities are flying over residential areas. Furthermore, law enforcement departments across Arizona are moving towards employing UAS in surveillance and tactical support roles. What are the parameters for UAS operation? Federalism Unit AAG Michael Hrnicek, Embry-Riddle Professor Sarah Nilsson, PhD, J.D., FAA Scottsdale Flight Standards District Office (FSDO) Frontline Manager of Operations Tina Buskirk, and FSDO Aviation Safety Inspector for Airworthiness Ernie Copeland will present the current state of UAS law and review recent cases.*
